



Care & Handling of Squirrel Tails

(Please follow carefully)

- 1) Tails are best on squirrels taken after October 1.
- 2) Do NOT remove the bone from the tail; deboned & split tails have no value.
- 3) Salt the butt end of the tail generously. Use either dry salt or dip in a strong saltwater solution.
- 4) Be sure the tail is straight before drying. Tails that dry curled are not-usable.
- 5) Keep tails away from flies. Best storage is in a freezer. Do NOT send tails that have been exposed to flies.
- 6) Do NOT put tails in a plastic bag for storage or shipment. They could heat-up and spoil. It is best to store tails in a cardboard box such as a shoe box.
- 7) The best time to ship is during the cold months (December, January, February, March), although dried squirrel tails may be shipped anytime.
- 8) Put your name, mailing address and phone number or e-mail address, along with the tail count inside EACH package.
- 9) **Shipping refunded on shipments of 50+ tails. Ship First Class Mail, First Class Parcel, Priority Mail if under 10 pounds or UPS ground if over 10 pounds. Pack without fill in smallest packaging possible.**

No refund on insurance charges, or service fees charged by independent mailing services.

Hair at base of tail must be at least 1" long

Fully - Usable Tail - \$0.12 each
